Forwarded Announcement (from AQSIQ – China's General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine):China's quality bureau informed us today that our 9E importation suspension is lifted. The public announcement (No. 146, Year 2006) states:

After AQSIQ issued Announcement No. 146, Year 2006, GE resolved the safety-related defect for PG9171 gas turbine generator set. Based on the evaluation of the experts group organized by AQSIQ, safety-related defects can be eliminated in gas turbine generators to be imported. After evaluation, AQSIQ decided to lift the importation suspension based on Announcement No. 146, Year 2006 immediately. All subsidiaries of AQSIQ are going to assume the custom inspection for GE PG9171E gas turbine generator set.
